Dear:

Yes, we can make these adapters if they are safe to use. However, please find out first what you actually have or we would cut the wrong size.

- -) What lathe do you have? Sherline? UNIMAT? China lathe? whatever
- -) Look in the manual of your lathe.
 - -) Sherline: MT0, MT1
 - -) Unimat: 7.2 mm straight boring -) China lathe: typically: MT2, MT3
- -) Measure the taper, have a look at

Measure the small end of the taper.

- -) Measuring arbors is tricky. Measure the wider end opening. Do you have a small diameter gauge? Do you have some known taper for test fitting?
- -) Do you need a taper or arbor? Taper to taper? Arbor to taper? I guess you look for a MT0 taper to MT1 arbor. Have a look at
